

KEEPING A HOLY LENT

How we keep a holy Lent can be challenging, but it can also be time for real change—or to use a churchy word, it can be a time for **conversion and rich spiritual growth.** The word 'lent' comes from the Anglo-Saxon word *lecton* referring to springtime. During these weeks of Lent we spiritually can begin to emerge from the winter and see the signs of new life.

As our Book of Common Prayer encourages us in the Ash Wednesday liturgy, “I invite you, therefore, in the name of the Church, to **the observance of a holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance; by prayer, fasting and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy Word.**”

Lent can be a time to clear away things that hinder us from a vibrant spiritual life, as well as a time to add new practices to our spiritual lives through prayer, study, and reaching out to others in Christian love.

We hope you will join us in our journey through Lent to Easter.

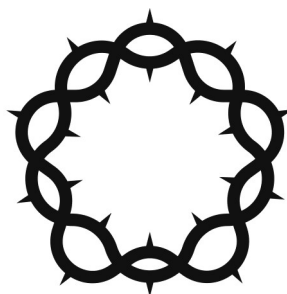
