UNACCEPTABLE DONATIONS. NO! Thank you.

St. Andrew's Shop cannot accept items of any type that are broken, chipped, cracked, damaged, dirty, odorous, scratched, worn-out, stained, torn, wet, moldy, rusty, frayed, disassembled or incomplete.

We do not accept the following items regardless of condition:

Wire Hangers
Food and used, recyclable food packaging containers.
Opened Cosmetics or Toiletries
Hazardous Materials
Medical Supplies or Equipment
Outdated Media: CDs without jewel cases, encyclopedias, VHS tapes, audio cassettes.
Fabric and Remnants
Used Bed Pillows

Unacceptable Types of Electronics: copiers, printers, scanners, fax machines, major appliances, rear projection TVs, smoke detectors, telephones.

Unacceptable Types of Books: any that are worn, torn, marked; outdated non-fiction; encyclopedias, magazines, professional journals, textbooks, teacher aides, student workbooks.
